What it does...

This program supports students aged 16 to 21 who have developmental disabilities and live in the Quad County Support Services catchment area as they transition from high school to adulthood..

The Goals...

The goal is to help connect students to their communities through employment, volunteering and recreational activities. As a result, students are gaining independence, forming connections in their community, learning more about the transition into adulthood, and having an enjoyable summer experience all at the same time.

How it works ...

Funded in part by our board of directors, each year we hire a student through Canada Summer jobs federal funding to run the program. Last year we helped six students find opportunities in their home communities.
